



Pointsec Disknet Pro 4.0

Product Description

1. Pointsec Disknet Pro is a unique corporate solution that provides a policy driven mechanism for securing an organisation's information whilst ensuring data integrity. Pointsec Disknet Pro provides security functionality that allows peripherals, media and files that can be attached or introduced onto a user's workstation to be controlled and monitored on a per user basis via a centrally maintained policy.

Common Criteria Certification – scope

2. The scope of the Common Criteria (CC) certification included the following security functionality:
 - Removable Media Manager (RMM).
 - Program Security Guard (PSG)
 - Port Guard (PG)
 - Data Authorization Module (Reflex DataScan).
 - Auditing and Monitoring (via the Disknet Pro Server software)
3. Potential users of the Pointsec Disknet Pro 4.0 product are advised that the following set of functions and services was not evaluated as part of the evaluation:
 - Encryption Policy Manager, which optionally supports the encryption of removable media.
 - Pointsec ScreenMail, which provides antivirus and active code protection for inbound and outbound emails, using Microsoft Outlook or Outlook Express.
4. Refer to the Common Criteria report (pp. 9-11) for the Pointsec Disknet Pro Version 4.0 product for the evaluated configuration.

Common Criteria Certification – summary

5. The product has met the requirements of the Common Criteria (CC) evaluation assurance level EAL2.

DSD Findings – summary

6. As the cryptographic functionality contained within the Pointsec Disknet Pro 4.0 was out of the scope of the Common Criteria certification, DSD did not conduct a cryptographic certification of this product.

7. Even though a DSD cryptographic evaluation was not performed, the product makes use of DSD Approved Cryptographic Algorithms (DACAs). As such, the Pointsec Disknet Pro 4.0 product can be used to reduce the storage and handling of the following information from:
 - IN-CONFIDENCE to UNCLASSIFIED; and
 - HIGHLY-PROTECTED to PROTECTED.
