ITEM NO. 120/1964: Reference File S200 - TACTICAL SIGINT SUPPORT IN BORNEO

The Chairman drew the attention of members to Defence Committee Minute No.3(S)1964 which endorsed, subject to certain amendments, the proposals put forward under JIC(S/C). Minute No.S/200 of 5th May. He pointed out that the Defence Committee in paragraph 3(g) of its minute:

"agreed that detailed arrangements for implementing the proposal should be resolved between the Director DSD and the AMF authorities".

- 2. The Chairman suggested that it would be of interest to members to be kept informed of the progress of the operation and the value of the results achieved. He had asked D/DSD to let him know how matters progressed, and considered it might be useful for members to discuss the subject informally from time to time.
- 3. Lt. Col. Mulholland explained the growing responsibility of the Army in this operation.
- 4. The Committee agreed that such discussions would be of value and that it was important for members to be kept informed.
