YOUR 140806. WE COMPLETELY ENDORSE YOUR SENSIBLE AND NECESSARY RULING. NO STATION OR OPERATOR SHOULD TAKE ON ITSELF/HIMSELF DECISIONS RELATING ALLOCATION OF COVER OR USE OF COVER RESOURCES—THAT IS OUR JOB AS COMMONWEALTH CENTRE BEARING IN MIND OVERALL REQUIREMENTS AND TOTAL RESOURCES AVAILABLE.
